



2007-08 CADET GYMNASIUM ENTRANCE POLICIES

- **The Cadet Gymnasium will open 1 hour prior to the start of the event.**
- **All persons and personal belongings entering the Cadet Gymnasium are subject to search.**
- **The following items are NOT permitted in the Cadet Gymnasium:**
 - **Alcoholic beverages**
 - **Artificial noisemakers of any kind**
 - **Backpacks to include bota bags, wine-skins, and camelbacks**
 - **Infant carrier packs permitted if infant is present**
 - **Bags larger than 8 x 11 inches. Hard-sided bags or coolers**
 - **Diaper bags are permitted if infant is present**
 - **Banners or large signs**
 - **Cameras with lenses greater than 4 inches in length**
 - **Handheld video cameras are permitted**
 - **Glass containers or cans**
 - **Empty transparent soft plastic bottles 24 oz. or less are permitted**
 - **Items that can not be readily inspected**
 - **Items deemed dangerous or unsafe by security personnel**
 - **Laser pointers**
 - **Pets (other than working service dogs)**
 - **Sticks, poles or umbrellas**
 - **Weapons, Firearms, Fireworks**
- **Flash photography is not permitted.**
- **Food and Drink are permitted under the following conditions**
 - **Food items are allowed if all items can be readily inspected.**
 - **Factory-sealed transparent soft plastic water bottles, 24 oz. or less are permitted**
- **Reentry is not permitted.**
- **Seatbacks 18 inches or less are permitted. Seatbacks will be permitted as long as they don't require a search due to excessive pockets and compartments.**
- **Storage of prohibited items is not provided.**
- **All cadets must have their military ID card and game ticket, if applicable, to enter the Cadet Gymnasium. Cadets are allowed to enter with backpacks but are subject to search.**
